The Allegheny County Community Program is Allegheny Family Network's (AFN) in-house, non-clinical support program. AFN will assign you a Family Support Partner who collaborates with your current service providers to plan the best course of action.

Your Family Support Partner will:

- Guide your family as you navigate Education, Children, Youth & Families, Juvenile Justice, Mental Health and other child-serving systems
 - Educate your family on ways to meet basic life needs such as housing, food, medical care, and employment
 - Help you identify and grow your family's strengths
 - Assist you in building family support within the community
 - Empower you to serve as your child's advocate
